FDOT has requested that AT&T Florida remove or relocate its facilities in the way of this project before January 30, 2026.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) intends to retire copper facilities serving Distribution Areas (DAs) 1111B, 2208C and 2208E in the Fentress Wire Center (DYBHFLFN) in Daytona Beach, FL due to the impact of the planned Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Volusia County Stormwater Conveyance Improvement Project PW-RB-10 along Morris Blvd. FDOT has requested that AT&T Florida remove or relocate its facilities in the way of this project before January 30, 2026.</p> <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Florida (AT&T Florida) intends to retire copper facilities serving distribution area (DA) 134104 in the Perrine Wire Center (PRRNFLMA) in Pinecrest, FL due to the impact of an easement dispute with The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) and a Customer Work Order (CWO). FDOT has requested that AT&T Florida remove or relocate its facilities in the way of this project before February 28, 2026.</p> <p>AT&T Florida plans to migrate customers currently served by copper facilities to existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) facilities and then retire the copper facilities.</p>
