| <b>Descriptive Narrative:</b>      | <p>BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&amp;T Tennessee intends to retire copper facilities serving distribution area (DAs) 5109 and 5118 in the Eastland (MMPHTNEL) wire center in Memphis, TN due to damaged facilities of copper cable. While AT&amp;T Tennessee technicians made repairs sufficient to sustain service to affected customers, the damage degraded the copper facilities to the extent that complete replacement would be necessary as a permanent solution.</p> <p>Further, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&amp;T Tennessee intends to retire copper facilities serving distribution area (DA) 1102b in the Southland Wire Center (MMPHTNSL) in Memphis, TN due to the impact of the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) planned road construction project. This project will construct improvements and includes the construction of new sidewalks, drainage, bicycle lanes and traffic signals. The city has requested AT&amp;T Tennessee to remove or relocate its facilities in the way of this project before September 30, 2025.</p> <p>Rather than replace the copper facilities AT&amp;T Tennessee plans to migrate customers served by the copper facilities to existing Gigabit Passive Optical Network/Fiber-to-the-Premises (GPON/FTTP) and then retire the copper facilities.</p> |
